

## **ASHE COUNTY STUDIO TOUR - ARTIST'S DESCRIPTIONS OF THEIR WORK**

HELEN BARNES-RIELLY – Photography and paintings of local flora, fauna and folk plus some whimsical rock art.

DAVID BRIDGE –Functional, wheel thrown stoneware pottery inspired by the Hun Dynasty glazes.

SYNDI AND RENEE BROOKS – Intricately designed and painted barn quilts for your home, office, barn or outbuilding.

BERKELEY BROWN – Intricate and whimsical over dye batik wall hangings, clothing and housewares individually crafted with beeswax and tjanting tools.

DALE CARLSON – Photography that provides a full experience of the colorful landscapes and culture for the mountain lover in you.

KELLY CLAMPITT - Photography of Appalachia life, native plants, wildlife, unusual landscapes, photo montage and raw documentary shots.

CYNTHIA DIXON - Rich, vivid colors and glowing hues flow within realism and abstract paintings, illustrating the warmth of our world.

MARTHA ENZMANN - Multi-media painting, prints, indoor/outdoor sculpture and glass design that create moments of surprise and delight.

JANE MUNROE FLOYD - Luminous botanical collage using textural, colorful papers and light illumination on hand constructed lampshades, sun catchers, 2-D nature art and floral jewelry.

CARLA HOUCK – Functional and decorative handwoven baskets in a variety of styles some with wood bases and handles, some with color, all beautiful!

GEORGE KOSINSKI – New paintings primarily oil on canvas as part of post stroke period involving new perspectives and impressions of natural and organic subjects.

ROSIE KOSINSKI – Representational and abstract paintings and prints inspired by nature, animals, colors of landscape, and textures of organic objects.

DEBORA MAUSER – Handcrafted art jewelry made from mixed metals, stones and enamel.

SUSAN MEREDITH - Yarn spun from local wool, weaving, knitted originals, other fiber art items and sparkly jewelry.

CAMILLE MORGAN - Original three-dimensional work in stained glass and copper, from whimsical to contemporary, for home and garden.

PAT MORRISON – Decorative and functional creations in clay and mixed media created and inspired by intuition, imagination, nature and whimsy.

MARY-ANN PRACK - Abstract, boldly colored, large scale figurative sculpture, paintings, drawings and outdoor sculpture garden.

CHERYL ROBERTS – Heritage craft of rug hooking including rugs, pillows, wall hangings, hats and more all made of hand dyed wool strips and handspun yarn.

PATRICK ROBERTSON – Vividly painted, functional sculptures from paper and wood; “fantastical” creature boxes and flying critters!

CHER SHAFFER – Mixed media folk and outsider art including dolls and paintings on paper, wood, and canvas.

MILT SIGEL – Original sculpture, paintings and relief in many mediums by Fine Arts and Fulbright Artist Scholar.

DOLORES SOMERS - Original, primitive, hand-hooked, 100% wool rugs in historic colors, and punch needle and applique work.

CAROL THOMPSON – Unique hand-built ceramic bowls, cups, and beads incorporating raw organic texture/patterns contrasted with colorful glazes; paper collage cards.

DAWN WICKLOW - Paintings and jewelry which incorporate Eastern and Western approaches to art.

HOLLIS WILD - Wool fibers worked with soap, water and motion to bind the fibers into useful objects including wall hangings, hats, and more.

CHERYL WILLIAMS – Functional and decorative pottery inspired by Seagrove craftspeople and the Blue Ridge Mountains.

JENNIFER GARDINER WILSON - Wheel-thrown, functional pottery with incised surface figures slipped figurative decoration.
